The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. with a welcome by Ms. Schlageter. Roundtable introductions ensued. Brief discussion ensued regarding the experience of everyone present in writing, assisting, preparing and/or reviewing grants. Consensus was reached to approve the January meeting minutes.

Ms. Schlageter shared the following updates concerning the promotion of www.deltonaFORyou.org:

- The parent and faith tool kits have been developed with inserts created and information from partner agencies included (handout). They will be assembled and Deborah will get in touch with those who have indicated wanting a specific number of kits as soon as they are ready.
- Correspondence has been forwarded regarding several key community events and promotional materials will be available to partners participating in these events. For more giveaways, please ask staff.
- A letter will be drafted and forwarded to area Deltona businesses regarding the website and other promotional items (i.e. window clings)
- The website is being updated regularly and content is being developed with the purpose of being added after the project's funding ends the end of May.

Ms. Klasne reminded attendees that Deltona FOR You is on Facebook so become a fan of our page if they use this resource. Ms. Schlageter referred attendees to a copy of a letter from Deltona High School regarding their April 7th Community Showcase event (handout). An update regarding the Florida EYI Project was provided.

The meeting's presentation, "Grant Writing Tips" was presented by Suzan Arrowood and Susan Little from Florida Powersports Safety Council. Both attended a grant writing conference in December which was made possible, in part, by the Deltona Prevention Project mini-grants. Ms. Schlageter followed their presentation by offering tips and handouts via PowerPoint.

The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 23rd from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. in the Commission Chambers at the City of Deltona (2345 Providence Blvd., Deltona). The key speaker will be Tim Sylvia from The United Way of Volusia/Flagler. There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
