The meeting was called to order at 10:45 a.m. with a welcome by Ms. Schlageter. Roundtable introductions ensued. Ms. Schlageter expressed appreciation to the City of Deltona for continued support and use of space for the monthly Deltona Prevention Project meetings. Roundtable member announcements ensued.

Project Business

Ms. Schlageter shared that she received a site visit on September 29th from the Community Coach for the project; the meeting consisted of identifying any technical assistance needs the Deltona Prevention Project might have at this time (none). She also announced that the reviewed the second round of mini-grants were awarded, totaling \$9,765. The status of the action plan was provided and she requested that all make special efforts to attend the December meeting since discussion will include moving into 2010 (announcements featured on pink handout).

The Florida EYI (Engaging Youth Initiative) facilitator training was held on September 30th and October 1st, involving 32 participants, 5 of whom were from Volusia County. The Deltona Family YMCA and R & R Ministries, Inc have indicated interest in this project which will be directed under the auspices of the Deltona Prevention Project. Jeffrey Moyer from The House Next Door presented "Teen Sexuality" citing data, trends, suggestions, etc. Questions and answers ensued.

There will not be a meeting in November. The next meeting will be **Thursday, December 10th, from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m.** (THIS IS A CHANGE IN DATE AND TIME FROM PREVIOUS ANNOUNCEMENTS) in the Commission Chambers at the City of Deltona. There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
