

PLUS GOALS:

- **Educate** students regarding the harmful effects of alcohol/drug use
- **Facilitate** positive changes in students
- **Prevent/Eliminate** substance use by our students

PLUS SERVICES

The **PLUS** Program serves referred students who are at risk for, suspected of or who have admitted to the use of alcohol/drugs. Services may include:

Assessment

Educational Groupwork

Case Management

Consultation

Community Referrals

Referrals may be initiated by teachers, guidance counselors, administrators, parents, or students requesting **PLUS** services.

REFERRALS TO COMMUNITY AGENCIES

Referrals are made to community agencies when it is determined that further assessment, counseling or treatment services may be needed.

Cost, if any, for assessment, counseling or treatment services is determined by the agency or service provider and is the responsibility of the parent.

STUDENT LEGAL RIGHTS

Pursuant to Federal Confidentiality Law 42 USC 290 dd-3, 290ee-3, students can expect that information discussed with the **PLUS** caseworker shall remain in confidence unless:

The Student signs a release of information form

OR

The student is a danger to self or others

OR

In cases of abuse/neglect

The **PLUS** Program is part of the Volusia County Schools Student Services Department. **PLUS** caseworkers are highly skilled prevention professionals who use proven and effective, research-based curriculum, approved by the National Center for Substance Abuse Prevention and the State of Florida Safe and Drug-Free Schools Office. **PLUS** caseworkers hold Certified Addiction Prevention Professional (CAPP) certification through the Florida Certification Board.

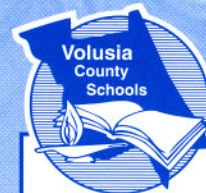
